ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD FOR FY2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to amend appropriations to meet expenditures in the capital projects fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND THE STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The appropriations in the following fund be amended as follows:

<u>Section 2</u>. Wherefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and upon its adoption and approval.
