

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL
PROJECTS AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD
FOR FY2023
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS it becomes necessary to amend appropriations to meet expenditures in the capital projects fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND THE STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The appropriations in the following funds be amended as follows:

FUND	DEPT	AMOUNT	NOTES
101 General Fund	101	\$112,000.00	2024 Police Cruisers
401 Capital Projects	602	13,125.00	Detroit Rd. Sewer – Cost of Issuance

Section 2. It is found and determined that formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance be, and hereby is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide adequate money for the public health, peace and welfare of the Village of Sheffield, Ohio, appropriating money to existing funds for the 2023 appropriations. Wherefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and upon its adoption and approval.
