

ORDINANCE NO. 2855

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE / DECREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN VARIOUS FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD FOR FY2022 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to amend appropriations to meet expenditures within the funds listed below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND THE STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The appropriations in the following funds be amended as follows:

Wherefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and upon its adoption and approval.
