 - RITA news alert: "On July 2, 2020 the Buckeye Institute has filed a lawsuit against both the City of Columbus and the State of Ohio claiming that the state law allowing municipalities to continue to collect municipal income tax from employees working from home during the Governor's declaration of emergency was unconstitutional. We will keep our members apprised as this litigation progresses. THIS LAWSUIT is scheduled to go to trial in July 2021. RITA is still working on estimating the impact this could have to the Village.
